

Apple Back to School Promotion '09 (USA)



Offer

Purchase a Mac and an iPod with Apple's Education Individual discount and receive up to a \$229 mail-in rebate. Qualifying products must be purchased on the same sales receipt from May 27, 2009, through September 8, 2009.

Qualified Participants

Faculty and staff of higher education institutions; and students attending or accepted into a higher education institution are eligible to purchase. Any employee of a public or private K-12 institution in the United States or District of Columbia is eligible. School board members who are currently serving as elected or appointed members are eligible. PTA or PTO executives currently serving as elected or appointed officers are eligible. Parents purchasing on behalf of their child, who is a student currently attending or accepted into a public or private higher education institution in the United States, are eligible to purchase.
